Wapaskwa Virtual Collegiate (WVC) is a First Nations Education Initiative that partners with First Nation schools to offer content-rich, credit-bearing high school courses to First Nation students across Manitoba. We are pleased to announce the opening of our 2010 - 11 Pilot Program! The 2010 - 11 Pilot Program is offered entirely over the Internet in a virtual classroom format, with the daily presence of a teacher.

Fully qualified WVC-trained teachers conduct the online class, which is designed for approximately 80-minutes of instruction per day (Monday – Friday). Students can take the WVC Pilot, allowing for greater flexibility in their academic environment in conjunction with your school community. WVC also provides student support via phone, email and Elluminate sessions.

Registration:

Fees:

Registration is free for the 2010 - 11 Pilot Program.

Student Responsibilities:

Students are responsible for knowing and adhering to the policies and procedures that are described in this section. Failure to read the policies and procedures does not excuse students from the rules described herein.

- **Attendance**
WVC students are expected to attend and participate in their course daily. All assigned work should be completed in a timely fashion. Students must participate actively in course discussions. Students are required to attend and perform in their class five times per week, Monday through Friday. Students should expect 80 minutes of coursework per day. A student who neglects coursework or has excessive or unexcused absences may be required to withdraw from the course. Required withdrawal from a course is equivalent in all respects to failing it; the student is assigned a grade of WF (withdrawal fail) and earns no credit for the course. In cases of extended absence due to illness (two days or more), the student or the student's parent / guardian should notify the teacher directly of any delay in providing assigned work. It is the responsibility of the student to make up work missed due to absence.
- **Academic Honesty**
All work submitted to meet course requirement is expect to be the student's work. A student suspected of academic dishonesty in any form is subject to review and disciplinary action by the WVC Administration. Disciplinary action may result in withdrawal from the course.

- **Acceptable Internet Use Policy**
All students participating in WVC courses are expected to conduct their communications in a professional and respectful manner. The use of proper Internet etiquette is expected at all times. Inappropriate language or behavior will result in disciplinary action and possible withdrawal from the course at the discretion of the WVC administration.

- **Anti-Harassment Policy**
WVC is committed to safeguarding the right of all individuals involved in school to work and learn in an environment that is free of harassment. Harassment on the basis of race, colour, ancestry, religion, national origin, age, sex, sexual orientation or disability in any form will not be tolerated and may result in withdrawal from the course.

- **Student Discipline**
As in any classroom, the WVC teacher will attempt to address discipline problems directly with the student prior to referring the student to WVC Administration. If the instructor is unable to resolve the problem or if the infraction is such that it requires administrative notification, the teacher will contact the WVC Administration and appropriate disciplinary action will be taken.
